- Vision: We ensure that Dauphin County is a safe place to live by prioritizing resources to our justice system that reduce the likelihood offenders will have future contact with law enforcement agencies.
- **Mission:** The mission of the Dauphin County Criminal Justice Advisory Board (CJAB) is to enhance the criminal justice system and public safety through the collaborative and targeted approach which prioritizes the support of evidence-based practices and innovative strategies while maintaining fiscal responsibility and maximizing outside resources.

- 5. To integrate into practice via a strong collaborative framework supported by county government administration, information-sharing strategies across human service and criminal justice agencies.
