Partnering with Dauphin County Parks & Recreation, Gamut Theatre Group, Sankofa African American Theatre Company, and The National Civil War Museum, a century of American history flickers through one man's memory in this lyrical new drama. On a single summer night, Ephraim Slaughter who was once enslaved, then a soldier and now a keeper of forgotten truths invites the audience into his modest Harrisburg home. As lamps dim and cicadas hum, voices of the past press against the present urging Ephraim to decide what must be spoken aloud before dawn and what must stay buried with him. Freedom's Witness is not a history lesson. It's a door left ajar. Ephraim welcomes you to step inside and hear freedom breathe. Teaching students and residents about local black history that is not frequently taught, the program will be held for both local students (free of charge) and the general public.




