Expungement Law: 18 Pa.C.S.A. 9123 Rules 170 and 172

Dauphin County Juvenile Probation Department Delinquency Expungment Guide

The enclosed instructions and information regarding the law and expungement process should only be used as a reference.

This information should not be interpreted as legal advice and consultation with an attorney is highly recommended.

Circumstances where a juvenile record is potentially eligible for expungement:

- 6 months have elapsed since the completion of Informal Probation or a Consent Decree and no
 proceeding seeking adjudication or conviction is pending.
- 2 years have elapsed since the completion of formal probation for misdemeanor charges;
 excluding firearms related and certain offenses under Section 3126 (A2) or (A3) which move to the 5 year guideline, <u>AND</u> since final discharge, the juvenile has not been convicted or adjudicated delinquent of a felony or misdemeanor <u>AND</u> there are no proceedings pending seeking such conviction or adjudication.
- 5 years have elapsed since the completion of formal probation for felony or firearms related
 misdemeanors and certain offenses under Section 3126 (A2) or (A3) AND since final discharge, the
 juvenile has not been convicted or adjudicated delinquent of a felony or misdemeanor AND there are
 no proceedings pending seeking such conviction or adjudication.

By law, there are several offenses that are <u>NOT</u> eligible for expungement. If the juvenile was 14 years of age and older and any of the following charges were adjudicated, then the record cannot be expunged:

- · Any offense under section 3121 (relating to Rape)
- Any offense under section 3123 (relating to IDSI)
- Any offense under section 3125 (relating to Aggravated Indecent Assault)
- · An attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to commit any offense under sections 3121, 3123, or 3125
